Health and safety regulations

for the return of decontaminated equipment and components

General Information

The „Declaration of Decontamination“ serves to document all safety-relevant information for the return of (de-)contaminated instruments and components. The customer (operator) is responsible for the health and safety of all persons who come into contact with the items sent in. This responsibility extends from the Operator's own personnel via the shipping company to the unpacking and maintenance personnel of LINSEIS who come into contact with the equipment and its components. Any contamination of the equipment and components must be identified, even if it has been completely removed, and the declaration of decontamination must always be completed.

Decontamination declaration

The personnel carrying out the repair and/or maintenance must be informed of the condition of the potentially contaminated equipment and components before starting work. This is the purpose of the legally binding "Declaration on Decontamination of Devices and Components". This declaration must be sent to LINSEIS. A second copy must be enclosed with the accompanying documents of the shipment.

Shipping

When shipping devices and components, the shipping instructions given in the operating manual must be observed before shipping.

For example:

- Decontaminate the appliance by using suitable procedures (flushing lines, heating/outgasing, cleaning with the correct solvent, etc.).
- The items sent in must be freed from hazardous substances at least until they are harmless

The declaration need to be placed outside the transport packaging!
